the improvements more than half I Give to
my Brother Durham Orrs two Daughters
namely Mary Orr & Elizabeth Orr one bed and
furniture Each

I Give to Lewis Orr one cow & calf

I Give to Lewis Orr & Samuel Orr one leverlap
Each & all my pot ware

I Give to Mary Orr & Elizabeth Orr two tables
& six chairs

I Give to Lewis Orr my Loom & my chest

I do Nominate and appoint Lewis Orr
and Samuel Orr my Nephews Executors of
this my last will & testament in testimony
whereof I have hereunto set my hand
and seal this the third day of
November in the year of our Lord
