future increase of them together with all & every
Bond note & account due to me & whatsoever
sum or sums of money as I may be in possession
of & all & all my farming utensils & Tools
I have & to hold the said tract of Land, negroes
household furniture Stock Bonds notes accounts
money farming utensils Tools Goods & chattels
of every kind hereby granted bargained & sold &
every part & parcel thereof unto the said Sally Swift

her Executors Administrators heirs & assigns with
& their own proper goods chattels & effects from
hence forth for ever Provided always & these presents
& upon this special Trust & Confidence & upon
this express condition That the said Sally Swift my
love Wife her heirs Executors Administrators &
shall & do permit & suffer me the said Flower
to use keep & enjoy all & singular the said Tract
of Land goods Chattels & effects during my natural
life without paying or yielding my things for
same or in respect thereof & not otherwise & from
after my decease she the said Sally Swift my
lawfull & beloved wife her heirs Executors Admini-
strators & assigns shall may lawfully have hold & enjoy
the same & every part & parcel thereof & dispose
thereof & convert the same to her & their own proper use
& behoof as she & they shall think fit & whereas
