 that my Grey Horse & my Tobacco, one yearling
 & what living Hogs my wife can spare, and
 all other property that can be best spared
 to be appropriated to my lawful debts—
 all the rest of my household and kitchen
 furniture to be appropriated to my
 beloved wife Benor Garrison and three
 Children (Wiz) Thirst Levi second David
third Barnabas, and that thirdly my planta-
 -tion and land, be rented annually and the
 benefits arising appropriated to their support,
 and this to be attended to untill the Children
 come of age— and then to be sold and
 equally divided between my said wife and
 Children as the law directs, and it is my
 desire that my brother Levi Garrison, do &
 I do hereby appoint him as Executor to
 and for the Execution of this my last will
 and Testament, signed & sealed this fifth
 day of December 1811
