by the name of Bay & her Child Caroline with a
Quantity of notes Books accounts & receipts
for notes & accounts out for Collection together with
the household & Kitchen Furniture one Gray mare
nine head of Cattle one or Cart with what boys I have
also the present Crop with all my Plantation & work
Tools & further that all my Just Debts be paid
out of the above mentioned notes & assets

Secondly I give & bequeath to my beloved Cousin Bright
W. Hargraves one Lot of Land lying in Cowing
County in said known by Lot Number 25
in the Eleventh District of said County drawn by
me & not granted also one third part of a Lot of
Land in Appling County drawn by Daniel
Gibson & known by number one hundred & ten
in the ninth District of said County
The Control of which is in the hands of James
Quillen Jun. also a Roan Filly six months old
with my new saddle also my Rifle Gun & shot
Bag

Patsy Pritchett Exec & Receivess of my Last will &
Testament hereby ratifying confirming this & no
other to be my last will & Testament In witness
