my worldly Estate, first all my just and

-ter Elizabeth one hundred Dollars -
I also give to my grandson Edward Hinnings
one hundred dollars, I also give to my grand
daughter Mary Hinnings one feather bed &
furniture, I also desire that one hundred
dollars be divided amongst the rest of
Elizabeth Hinnings children, I also give
to my loving son William Gilbert two
hundred Dollars, I give to my grandson
Edward Gilbert one negro boy named Cedy,
I give to my grand daughter Mary Gilbert
one feather bed and furniture, I give the
rest of William Gilbert children one
hundred dollars to be equally divided
I do ordain and appoint John Gilbert and
