I Joseph Glenn senior of the State of Georgia
and County of Hancock being weak and infirm
in body but of perfect mind and memory knowing
that it is appointed by almighty God for all men
to die and the time of that awful change as it
respects myself is to me unknown, In order that
I may appear as is in my own power be prepared
for that most awful but certain change which
will close my transactions here with all
transitory and worldly concerns - I make and

I declare this my last Will and Testament in
Hopes of mercy from the Almighty God for the
Redemption sake. Recommend my soul to Him from
whom I received it and my being. I recommend that
my Body be buried in a decent & Christian manner
by my Executors. And my estate both real and
personal of which I am at this time possessed
or that is in any way my lawful right. I will and
direct that the same be divided, disposed and
applied in the manner and form following
to wit, I give & bequeath to my beloved wife
Nancy Glenn the following negroes, say old Tom,
Big Tom, Silvey, Phillis, Big Rachel, & her child
Elijah and the future increase of said Silvey,
Phillis & Rachel and all the plantation utensils
of every kind &c, also all my stock of horses,
cattle hogs &c. also all my house hold & kitchen
furniture including beds &c also all debts
due to me, all of which property both real &
personal to be and belong to my beloved wife
Nancy Glenn to be fully & clearly at her disposal
on the following Conditions, that is that
she out of the property left to her as aforesaid
pay all the just debts that I ~~own~~ and as my
sons John Glenn William Glenn, Thornton ^{Thompson} Glenn
Hopsaon Glenn, and Simdon Hollendon Glenn, arriving
at the age of twenty one year (or sooner if either of
them marries) that she my said wife do out of the
property left to her as aforesaid pay to each of my
aforesaid sons one horse saddle and bridle which
shall at the time the same is paid be worth one
hundred dollars; also that she do take proper
care of and provide for my then last mentioned
children say Thornton & Glenn Matthew H. Glenn
and Simdon & Glenn sufficient clothing, boarding
washing &c. till they and each of them arrive
to the age of twenty one year and also that she

do within said term I give each of the aforesaid
three last mentioned Children good English Educa-
-tion - Secondly, I give and bequeath to my
son John Glenn two negro boys say Simon
and Brun, also one horse saddle and
bridle to be worth one hundred dollars, to
be paid to him by his step mother, when
he arrives at the age of twenty one years
(or sooner if they marry) at which time he is to have
possession of the negroes now given him and not so-
oner, but said negroes to remain in the possession of
his step mother untill he arrives at the age of twenty
one years (or marries) as aforesaid should he live that
long - Thirdly I give & bequeath to my son William
Glenn two negro boys say Charles and James
also one horse saddle and bridle to be paid to
him by his step mother as I have before directed
which horse saddle and bridle is to be worth
one hundred dollars & to be paid to him when
he arrives at the age of twenty one years (or ~~marries~~
if he marries) at which time he is also to take possession
of the negroes hereby given him and not sooner,
but said negroes to remain in possession of his step
mother untill he marries or becomes of age should
he live that long - Fourthly I give & bequeath to
my son Thornton Glenn two negro boys say Lucy & Billy
and the future increase of the said Lucy, also one
horse saddle and bridle to be worth one hundred
dollars, to be paid to him as I have before directed
by his mother when he arrives at the age of twenty
one years or sooner if he marries -
Fifthly I give and bequeath unto my son Matthew
Glenn two negro boys say Spencer & Winny and the
future increase of said Winny also one horse
saddle and bridle to be paid to him as I have
before directed by his mother when he arrives at
the age of twenty one years or sooner if he marries
said horse saddle to be worth one hundred dollars -

Sixthly I give and bequeath to my son Samuel G. Glenn two negroes say little Rachel & Nathan and the future increase of said Rachel and also one horse saddle and bridle to be worth one hundred dollars to be paid to him when he is twenty one years of age (or marries) by his mother as I have before directed —

Seventhly I give and bequeath to my daughter Lucy Brown one negro girl named Fanny and her future increase —

Eighthly I give and bequeath to my daughter Polly Blumette one hundred dollars for which I have this day taken Hugh Macdonald note payable to her two years after date for that amount which note is to be in full of her share of my estate —

Ninthly I give and bequeath to my son Joseph Glenn one negro girl named Fanny and her future increase —

Tenthly, whereas I have already given to my son Edwin Glenn and to my daughter Polly Emory their and each of their portions of my estate, I now only give & bequeath to each of them the said Joseph and Polly the sum of one dollar each as their share of my estate —

Eleventhly should either of my sons John and William Glenn die before the one so dying arrives at the age of twenty one years, it is my will that the whole of the property by me bequeathed to the one so dying go to the other or survivors of my sons John and William and not generally among the rest of my children —

Twelfthly should either of my sons Thornton or Isaac Matthew St. Glenn or Samuel G. Glenn die before the one so dying arrives at the age of twenty years it is my will that the whole of the property of the one so dying go to the survivors and so in course of the death of two of said children and not generally among the rest of my children —

Thirteenthly it is my will that my three youngest children

remain with and be solely under the direction
and management of their Mother (if she then
-ld live) till they individually arrive at the
age of twenty one years -
Therefore I hereby appoint my beloved wife
Nancy Glenn my beloved brother Simon Glenn
and my beloved brother in law William
Goodeby my Executors - And having
maturely considered every part and clause
of this my last Will and Testament I am
therewith fully content and I do hereby
revoke and make void all other & former
wills by me made, and I make and ordain
and confirm this as my ~~only~~ and last will
& testament in witness whereof I the said
Joseph Glenn senior have hereunto set my hand
& seal this 19th day of January Eighteen Hundred
and ten -
