Secondly my body I commit to the earth at the discretion of my Executors herein after to be named

Thirdly & as to such worldly estate it has been pleased God to entrust me with I dispose of in the following manner

First that all the just Debts & funeral expenses be speedily paid by my Executors

Secondly I will & bequeath to my beloved wife Mary Hollingsworth and negro woman by the name of Fanny & her child Caesar to be her right & property during her natural Life as well as all my household furniture & all my stock of every kind for the support of herself & family during Life & at her decease the aforesaid property to be equally divided between my four sons Jacob Thomas James & Benjamin Hollingsworth during the life time of my beloved Son Samuel Hollingsworth I distributed & give to him as much as intended him to have of my worldly goods nevertheless in consideration of the great affection that I bear to his memory I will & bequeath to heirs

To Mary Dobbins one Dollar To John Hollingsworth  
To Henry Hollingsworth one Dollar & To Hannah Hollingsworth  
one Dollar

To Jacob & James Hollingsworth Twenty Dollars to  
to them by my Executors out of my Estate

Having also given to my Daughter Sally Garner in  
time & to her heir Jacob Garner the sum of one Dollar  
raised & paid out of my Estate by my Executors

5<sup>th</sup> Also for the Love & Affection I bear unto my bel-

my Estate including the following negroes by  
Jacob, Henry, Harry, Lett & Marion to be equally  
divided between my four sons as above at my Death

8<sup>th</sup> I will & bequeath unto James & Benjamin Hollingsworth  
also my set of Smiths Tools

9<sup>th</sup> I do revoke all other will or wills by me heretofore  
Confirming & ratifying this as my last will & Testa-

10<sup>th</sup> I do ordain constitute & appoint Thomas Hollingsworth  
& Benjamin Hollingsworth Executors of this my  
will & Testament Signed, sealed & acknowledged  
This fifteenth day of May in the year of our Lord  
one thousand eight hundred & fifteen
