

State of Georgia In the name of God the
 Franklin County I throwing that man is man
 and that the term of life is uncertain I do
 Jackson of the County and State aforesaid
 being weak in Body but of sound & disposing
 mind I now do make ordain & publish
 the following instrument as my last Will
 and Testament - It is my desire that
 my death my Body should be buried in a plain
 decent and Christian like manner and that
 I am be paid for by my Executors out of
 my Estate -

Item. It is my desire that so soon after my
 decease as convenient my Executors here
 after named and appointed, shall pay
 all my Just debts or demands that may
 be outstanding against me

And as to
 such worldly goods as it has been
 pleased God to bless me with in this
 life I bequeath and dispose of them
 the following manner (Viz)

I give and bequeath unto my beloved wife
 Hannah Jackson the following property
 one negro fellow by the name of Petham
 and negro woman named Rachel, and
 two feather beds & furniture also as much
 of my household & kitchen furniture as my
 wife Hannah Jackson may see proper to take
 for her own use -

Item It is my desire that after my decease that my
 beloved wife Hannah Jackson should live
 with my son Joseph Jackson during his
 natural life and it is my will that my son
 Joseph Jackson shall have the use of said negroes
 Petham & Rachel for supporting his mother Hannah

Jackson, during her natural life, and at her
decease the said negro and ~~her~~ furniture to
be equally disposed of by my Executors among
all my heirs herein after named -

Item, I give and bequeath unto my two sons
William Jackson & Joseph Jackson part of a
tract of land known as the David tract, it,
being all that ~~tract~~ part of said tract known
as the David tract lying on the East side of
the Road now leading from the Poplar Spring
meeting house to the Old River Road near
the place where Thomas Farmer now owns
known as the Reuben Farmers place

Item, I give and bequeath to my daughter Sarah
Gobbs one dollar to be paid out of my estate
after my decease to be paid by my Executors
herein after named -

Item, I give and bequeath to my daughter Rebecca
McFarland one dollar to be paid out of my
estate after my decease by my Executors herein
after named and appointed -

Item, I give and bequeath unto my daughter Mary
Chandler one dollar to be paid out of my
Estate after my decease by my Executors
herein after named and appointed -

Item, I give and bequeath to my daughter Rhoda
Thomas one dollar to be paid out of my estate
after my decease by my Executors herein after
named and appointed -

Item, It is my desire that so soon after my decease
as is convenient that my Executors herein
after named and appointed do proceed
to advertise and sell the tract of land
whereon I now live, together with part
of the tract known as the David tract but
it being that part lying on the west side

of the Road now leading from the poplar
Spring meeting house to the old River Road
near the place where Thomas Fanner now
owns. Known as the Bulbar Runway place
And also the balance of my negroes (to wit)
one boy Phosant, one boy Isaac one
boy Fannan and one boy Tom, one girl
Lucinda one girl Fanny, Together with
my stock of Horses, Cattle, Hogs, and
sheep, and farming tools, also the balance
of my house hold & kitchen furniture
that my beloved wife & Anniah Jackson
may not see proper to take for her use,
together with all the goods & Chattels that
I may be possessed of at the time of my
decease, and the proceeds of the same
to be equally divided among all my
Children to wit, Sarah Dobbs, William
Jackson, Joseph Jackson, Rebecca all
Farland Mary Chandler & Rhoda
Thomas or their legal Representatives
then, I do hereby appoint my sons William
Jackson & Joseph Jackson Executors of this
my last will & Testament, And I do hereby
revoke annul and declare all other
Wills or Codicils heretofore by me at any
time made and do declare and publish
the foregoing as my only true last Will & Testament.
In testimony whereof, I hereunto set my hand
and seal this Eleventh day of August in the year
of our Lord one thousand eight hundred &
thirty eight -
