My three Daughters to be taught to Read & Write well, My two Sons to be taught Reading Writing & Arithmetic as far as the Rule of Three Then if any of the above mentioned money should remain after Education the aforesaid children as above mentioned the said money then to be Equally divided among the said children And I do hereby appoint my Wife Ann Executor & John Chalmers, Jr. Executor of this my last will & Testament In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & Seal this 12th June 1815
