this as my last will and testament after committing
my soul to God and body to the dust from whence
it came and all funeral charges paid

- Item 1. My just debts first paid.
" 2 I will and bequeath unto my wife Rachael my
Land and Tenements during her life time
if she should be the longest lived and after
her death to my son Micajah Martin all
the Tract of Land I now live in in the
County of Franklin State of Georgia and
lying on the Middle Fork of Broad River
and likewise one other Tract containing six
and eight acres adjoining the same to Thomas
Davis and likewise a tract of one hundred
acres adjoining the same the place wherein
the said Micajah now lives Granted
to Jacob Pennington

- 74 Item 3 I will and bequeath unto my son Micajah Martin
one negro by the name of Ty likewise one neg-
boy named Will
- " 4th I will and bequeath unto my Daughter Mary
Martin One negro woman named Harriett
One negro girl named Liza one negro boy
named James One bay mare Colt One feather
bed and furniture one side board
- Item 5 I will and bequeath unto my Daughter Sarah
now married to William Belmont one negro man
named Tony at the death of my wife Rachad
if she should be the longest lived
- Item 6 I will and bequeath unto my Daughter Nancy now
married to John Ramsay one negro girl named
Leharitt
- Item 7 I will and bequeath unto my son Micajah Martin
Moses and Elizabeth my two old negroes also one
yoke flurs and cart also one Desk one cupboard
- " 8 I will and bequeath unto my three Daughters
Nancy and Mary and Sarah my house hold and
Kitchen furniture that is not otherwise disposed
of in the will to be equally divided among them
by sale or consent
- Item 9 I will and bequeath unto my wife Rachad my
Stock of hogs and cattle her life time & after
her death to be divided equally divided between
Micajah & Mary Martin if there should be
any
- " 10 I will and bequeath unto my son Lezlie and
Martin five dollars -
- " 11 I will and bequeath unto my son Andrew Martin
five dollars -
- " I will and bequeath unto my son James Martin five
dollars
- " 12 I will and bequeath unto my son Aaron Martin
five dollars

may occur and also to hire out Harriett
if necessary to keep my Daughter Mary
from any Expense of Raising her children
