Simpsen, humbly sheweth, that Richard Taylor
late of said County, Decd. in his lifetime (to-wit:
On the twenty eighth day of July Eighteen hundred
and six, entered into a certain obligation in
writing, wherein he acknowledged himself, held
& firmly bound unto the said Thos. Jenkins sur.
of said County, in the just and full sum of five
hundred dollars - conditioned, for that where-
as the said Thos. Richard Taylor - was by law sub-
mitted to two acres of land in the then existing land
lottery, and thereby bound himself to make a good
and lawful title in fee simple to any land that
he might draw in the said contemplated lottery
& one Moses Collier signed the said bond or
obligation as security for his faithful perform-
ance thereof, and the said Richard Taylor
afterwards died intestate and without will,
and having drawn a piece of land containing
two hundred two and a half acres, being known
by lot no. 288. in the twentieth district of Baldwin
County, now Morgan County, and having died
without performing the condition of the said
obligation, and whereas William Rich,
having taken upon himself the administration
of said estate, by letters of Administration to him
lawfully constituted by the Honorable Court -
the said Thos. Jenkins, the death of the

said Richard Taylor (twit) on the twenty
third day of February Eighteen hundred and
Eight, assigned over the Contents of said Will
-tion to your petitioner, whereby a right hath
accrued, to your petitioner to demand the per-
formance of the said Obligation to your
petitioner by the said William Rich, Admin-
-istrator of the said Intestate. Your petitioner therefore
prays that this Honorable Court may order &
direct the said William Rich as adminis-
-trator of said intestate to make and execute
title of the said lot of land as drawn by their
testator, according to his said obligation entered
into in his lifetime, and according to the me-
-aning and intent of an act of Assembly in
such case made & provided, and your
petitioner as in duty bound will ever pray
