of the County and State aforesaid, being in a bad state of health, but of sound judgment and memory, do make & ordain this my last will and Testament, in the following manner, viz: in the first place I leave my body to the grave to be buried in a decent manner at the discretion of my hereinafter named executor & executrix, and my soul to God who gave it, and a touching such worldly property as has pleased God to bless me with, I do hereby dispose of in the following manner, that is to say in the first place it is my will and desire that all my just debts shall be paid by my Executor & Executrix. Secondly I give and bequeath to my wife Sarah my negro woman Harriet during her natural life, and at her death to be sold and the proceeds to be equally divided among my Children or their representatives except my daughter Susanna Westbrook, whose Children I wish and request to have a child's part instead of her. In regard my other personal property and my real estate I leave to the discretion of Executor & Executrix to sell or otherwise dispose of in any manner they may judge most conducive to the interest of the family, and at the death of my beloved wife to be equally divided among my Children except a, above
