 of two hundred and twenty dollars, then
 the above negroes old wip to have to be paid
 out until such balance shall be made
 up, then, the above negroes together with
 all their future increase, I give & bequeath
 in manner as above mentioned, to them and
 their heirs forever, and I do also appoint
 & nominate my beloved sons Samy Hooper,
 and John Hooper my Executors of this my
 last will & Testament, hereby revoking and
 disannulling all will or wills by heretofore
 made, and hereby declaring this to be my
 last will & Testament in writing, whereof
 I have hereunto set my hand and affixed
 my seal this eighteenth day of Feb in the
 year of our Lord Eighteen hundred, and
 of the Independence of the United States
 of America the twenty fourth —

 of the county of Franklin and State of Georgia
 being now in a very low state of health, but
 perfectly in his senses, mind and memory, thanks

be to Almighty God for it, & calling into mind, and
 knowing that it is appointed me to die, do make &
 Ordain this my last will & Testament, that is to say
 principally & first of all, I give & recommend my soul
 into the hands of Almighty God who gave it me,
 and my Body I recommend to the Earth, to be buried
 in a Christianlike burial at the direction of my
 Executors hereafter. nothing doubting but at the
 general resurrection, I shall receive the same again
 by the mighty power of God, and as touching my
 worldly Estate, first all my just and lawful
 debts to be discharged - I give & bequeath unto
 my loving wife Mary the plantation whereon I now
 live, with all my personal estate during her wid-
 owerhood, and as my loving children become of age
 to have an equal part of the personal estate, but
 if my wife should marry then I only give her three
 negroes (twit) Ben, Sal, & Phillis with an equal part
 of all my personal Estate with my children -
 I give and bequeath to my loving son William and
 James the plantation whereon I now live with
 all my possessions of lands on Blacks Creek -
 Also I give to my loving son John one Thousand and
 dollar in specie when he become of age - also
 I give to my loving daughters Elizabeth & Nancy
 an equal part of all my personal estate when
 they become of age, I also leave to my loving
 Mother as much of the open land as she will want
 to till her lifetime, with two negroes, stee & mil,
 also the one half of my Dwelling house during
 her life - I do Ordain & appoint my loving wife
 Mary Gilbert, during her widowhood, Executor
 and Abner Franklin & Isaac Thickett Executors,
 in witness whereof I have unto at my hand and seal 1th day
 of April Eighteen hundred & three
