8th Lastly that this my last will & Testament may be carried fully into effect I ordain constitute & appoint my beloved son Joshua Westbrook & my friend Joseph Morris my sole Executors of this testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand & affixed my seal This Twenty fourth day of November in the year of our Lord Eighteen hundred & nineteen

Know All men by these presents that I John Baugh Sen. of the State of Georgia & County of Franklin hath this Day made this my last will & Testament in manner & form following viz
My Lands on the east side of the Grove River I give to my sons John & Mitchell Baugh Beginning at the Shener the Road to woods within Baugh to the corner of the old field fence thence with the upper line of the fence to the intersection of ~~the~~ Baugh as I give thence down to I Baugh line to the River & across the ~~the~~ River to the back line of the original Survey

That Square down the River below the Bridge
be the same more or less, I Give to my son John
Baugh Jun. & That Square of Land above the
Bridge joining Baugh & Moses Hendrix I give
to my son Mitchell Baugh, also my desire is
that my wife Dorkus Baugh remain to live
on my Land & plantation that I now live on
& in my house with her two Little Sons &
Daughter ~~Delia~~ & David Baugh & Patsy
Baugh, Having the use of my plantation
& house also the use of my negroes Solomon
& Rachel to work for her & to maintain the
Children Also to have the use of my horses
Cattle & Stock of all kinds Also the use
of my household & Kitchen furniture &
farming utensils & this years crop of corn
All to be & remain hers during Life or widow
hood & my Land on the west side of the Green River
to belong to Joshua & David Baugh beginning at the
mouth of my spring Branch running at the
branch to the back line between me & Jesse Black
well, That Square up the River I give to my son
Joshua Baugh & That Square down the River
I give to my son David Baugh, (my further desire
is that) my negro man Hauser be sold to
the highest bidder & my Cotton Crop be sent
to Augusta & sold & the money arising
from the negro & Cotton go to pay my last
& lawful debts & at the marriage of my
decease of my wife my desire is that all
my Estate be sold to the highest Bidder
the money be Equally divided among my
sons & daughters viz. John Baugh, John
Baugh, Mitchell Baugh, Joshua Baugh
David Baugh, Sealy Hendrix, Polly Smith
Nancy Sam, & Patsy Baugh, & I do here by
appoint my son John Baugh my true & lawful
Executor of this my last Will & Testament
