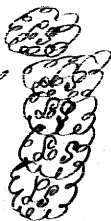

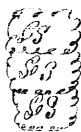

Superior Court of the County
aforesaid sitting for ordinary purposes
bearing date the 4 day of July 1815 for the purpose of

Dividing & Distributing into Six Equal parts or Shares agreeably to the provisions of an Act of the General Assembly in such Cases made & passed the following Negroes (To-wit) Niece, Joe, George, Bob, Slave, Phillis, Peter Rose, Eliza, Sarah, Maria & Jude being part of the Personal Estate of John Gilbert late of the County aforesaid deceased

We have divided the said Negroes into six parts or shares & have distributed the same as follows (To-wit) To James Allen, one share consisting of Niece & Joe. To Russel, J. Daniel George & Jude. To Nancy Gilbert, Bob & Maria. To John Gilbert Slave & Sarah. To William Gilbert Phil & Eliza. To James Gilbert Peter & Rose. It is to be understood that Nancy Gilbert shall pay to each of the other Distributees Four Dollars and one sixth of a Dollar Given under our hands & seals this 25th day of July 1815
