that is to say, principally and first of all, I give and recommend my Soul into the hand of Almighty God, that gave it. My body I recommend to the earth, to be buried in decent Christian burial, at the discretion of my Executors. Nothing doubting but at the general resurrection I shall receive the same again by the mighty power of God. And as touching such worldly estate wherewith it has pleased God to bless one in this life. I give, dismiss, and dispose of in the following manner and form.

First - I give and bequeath to my daughter Lucinda Steel one dollar.

Secondly - I give and bequeath to my daughter Aggy Harrilson one dollar.

Thirdly - I give and bequeath to my daughter Elizabeth Embry one dollar.

Fourthly - I give and bequeath to my daughter Patty Thomas one dollar.

Fifthly I give and bequeath to my Son Pierce Key one dollar-

Sixthly I give and bequeath to my daughter Winney Embrey and at the death of my beloved wife Jenny I give her twenty dollars.

Seventhly, I give and bequeath to my son Talbird Key one dollar-

Eightly, I give and bequeath to my daughter Sally Bailey one dollar.

Ninthly I give and bequeath to Son George W Keys one dollar.

Tenthly, I give and bequeath unto my two grand Children Loiza Bailey and George Key Bailey a certain tract of land lying on the water of the Beaverdam Creek adjoining Tolbert Key, beginning at Said Keys Hickory Corner running, thence to a post Oak corner formerly called Streets corner, thence to a red Oak at the dry pond thence to said Keys Blackjack corner, thence to the beginning Hickory Corner-

Eleventhly, the remaining part of my property of every nature, I give unto the hands of my Executor to sell and the money arising from the Sale of the Same I give and bequeath to my beloved wife Jenney Key during her natural life, and the lot of land in Early County, Sixth district, and eighty eighth number, I empower my Executors to sell when they shall deem it most Proper, and money arising from the Sale of the Same to be given to my wife and the above for her Support also the lot of land which I drew in Troup County. My Executors are empowered to sell the same & the money arising from the sale of said land to be given to my beloved wife during her natural life- Twelfthly after the death of my beloved wife Jenny Key I give and bequeath the whole of the remaining part of my estate to my three sons Pierce Key Talbird Key and George W Key, to be equally divided among them.

Thirteenthly I hereby ordain this to be my last Will and Testament and do appoint my beloved wife Jenny Key, Pierce Key and Gabriel Martin my Executrix & Executors - In testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand and official my Seal, this the Second of December in the year of our Lord, eighteen hundred and twenty

it is my wish and desire that there will be and equal division
to be made between my five children. And that my beloved wife
Retty Hemphill and Charles D. Jenkins is to act as Executors
