 memory make this my last will and testament as
 followeth, As to debts I thank God I owe none, therefore
 shall give my Executors no trouble on that account.
 But in the good old way bequeath my body to
 the Earth, and my soul to God who gave it.
 Therefore shall proceed to distribute all and
 singular my estate real & personal, between my
 Beloved wife Martha Strange and my two
 sons, namely Seth and Sterling. I therefore
 proceed in the first place to give to my
 beloved wife Martha all my household furniture
 and stock during her natural life time, I
 also give & bequeath unto my son Seth two
 certain lots of land one drawn in book
 the other in Group County, both drawn in
 my own name, together with what he has had
 of my estate heretofore with all the rest of my
 property that I have left my wife Martha at
 her death that he may maintain her free from
 want while she lives, I here give unto my
 son Sterling a horse bridle, Bed & furniture
 with other articles amounting to his full portion
 to his satisfaction. And do hereby appoint
 my son Seth and ordain him as my lawful
 Executor to act on & carry the same my last
 will & testament into effect. In witness I
 hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal
 this 19th day of June 1827

 In the name of God Amen, I, John Labor of the County of Franklin State of Georgia, knowing all others, appoint this to be my last Will and Testament, I give to my son John H Labor a negro girl named Nance, and to William Labor a negro girl named Hannah, for which he has paid back \$100- to make he equal with the rest. To Isaac Labor I give one negro girl named ^{copy} for which he paid back \$54. to make he equal to hiser ones. To Savannah Labor I give a negro girl named Silva, To James Labor I give a negro girl named Rutha & \$50. at the division of the property at my wifes death. To Francis A Labor I give a negro boy Peter & a girl named Vena and their mother Rachel at my wifes death, & also the land & premises whereon they dwell at my wifes death. I also give to my wife Elizabeth Labor a negro man named Lott and a negro woman named Rachel, & a girl named Elilly, and another by the name of Rose with all my lands goods and Chattels, after the payment of my Lawful
