Georgia In the name of God Amen, I John Labor
Franklin County of the County of Franklin State of Georgia
Sheweth all others, appoint this to be my last Will and
Testament, I give to my son John H Labor a negro
girl named Nance, and to William Labor a negro girl
named Hannah, for which he had paid back \$100 - to
make he equal with the rest. To Isaac Labor I give
one negro girl named ^{Lucy} for which he paid back \$54.
to make he equal to the other ones, To Susannah Labor I
give a negro girl named Silva, To Samuel Labor
I give a negro girl named Rutha & \$50. at the
division of the property at my wifes death. To Francis
A Labor I give a negro boy Peter & a girl named Vena
and their mother Rachel at my wifes death, & also the
land & premises whereon they dwell at my wifes death.
I also give to my wife Elizabeth Labor a negro man
named Lott and a negro woman named
Rachel, & a girl named Elilly, and another
by the name of Rose with all my lands, goods
and Chattels, after the payment of my lawful

I desire that my property arising therefrom. I also wish my executors to pay strict attention towards both that he does his duty in taking care of his mistress, which if he not give him ~~at~~ the highest bidder, and the funds to his mistress, and at my wifes death, I wish all that are not disposed of to be sold & equally divided amongst the legates, I also authorize my Executor to sell any land that I am possessed of or may be in the ensuing Spring in order to procure her proper residence for her during her natural life. I appoint John St Labor & Isaac Labor & William Labor to be executors of this my last will and Testament, Witness my hand and seal November the 11. 1825
