my cattle and all my house hold fur-
niture and all my plantation tools
and lastly I do hereby constitute and
appoint Jackson Hays & George
Shell my executors of this my last
will and testament hereby taking
all former wills by me made
and hereby Ratifying this my last
will and testament In testimony
whereof I have hereunto set my
hand and affixed my seal this
the 13th day of August 1846
