of my beloved wife Elizabeth H. Cook
until my youngest child comes to the

age of ~~one~~ ^{one} year, also the household and kitchen furniture, goods and Chattels in anywise appertaining to my estate -

Item. It is my will and pleasure that after the youngest Child comes of the age of twenty one year then and in that ~~and~~ event my property and its increase to be divided equally amongst my wife and Children giving to her her share of Dower or a Childs part as she may think proper to select -

Item. It is my will and I do hereby appoint Robert A R Neal my Executor to this my last Will & Testament - In testimony whereof, I have unto make my mark and Cause my seal to be affixed this fifth day of November in the year of our Lord Eighteen Hundred and forty three
