

I give and bequeath, after paying all just debts, I give and bequeath to my son Mace Clements & daughter Mary S. Clements all the property I possess or may possess in the State of Virginia - I give and bequeath to my son Mace Clements and daughter Mary S. Clements half of the Slaves I own in the State of Georgia - Whichever of them that takes the part of the property called Lamford and Davis shall have the privilege of using whatever timber or wood he or she may want -

I give and bequeath the remaining half of my Slaves in the State of Georgia to my son Meriwether Clements and John S. Clements Children -

I wish and desire that my Kentucky land and Franklin land in Georgia be equally divided between my son John S. Clements Children and Meriwether Clements -

I do constitute and appoint my son Mace Clements my Executor, do not require him to give security Signed and sealed this 27th day of July 1840 -

 first I give to my beloved wife Elizabeth Anthony
 the land whereon she now lives and Eight
 Negroes namely Pat Martha and her five
 Children Mary with the Stock household
 and Kitchen furniture and all plantation
 utensils to keep during her life and at her
 death all the above named property Except
 Mary I give to my son Martin Anthony
