

In the name of God Amen, I Henry Lyns of the county of Franklin & State of Georgia, being very sick and weak of body, but of perfect mind & memory, thank be given to God, calling unto mind the mortality of my body, & knowing that is appointed for all men once to die, do make & ordain this my last will & Testament; I first recom-mend my soul into the hands of almighty God and my Body to be buried in a Christian manner and as touching my worldly Estate, I dispose of it in the following manner - First I allow all my just debts to be ^{lawfully} paid - I give and bequeath unto Margarette my wife, the third part of all Estate, also I give to Margarette my daughter fifty dollars, I give likewise to my son Christopher, and to my son Adams heirs, one dollar twelve and a half cents - The residue and part of my Estate to be equally divided between my Daughters, Catharine, Ove, & Mary. I do hereby disannul all other wills and testaments before named or written, and ordain this and no other to be my last will and Testament - In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal this twentieth day of September in the year of our Lord one thousand Eight hundred and five -

to be paid out of my property, and then my
son Isaac to have one Cow and calf, my daugh-
-ter Nancy, I will one Horse saddle and
Bridle, four head of cattle, two Bed & furniture,
and my son Joseph I will & bequeath to him one
Horse saddle & Bridle and four head of
cattle, and my Daughter Annie, I will
and bequeath one Horse saddle & Bridle, four
head of cattle, & Bed & furniture, and my
son Moses - I will and bequeath to him one
Horse saddle and Bridle, and four head of
cattle in order to make them in proportion
to him that is married - And all my
working tools I leave to Joseph and Mary equ-
-ally to be divided, and the balance of my
Estate to be left to my best beloved wife, in-
-during widowhood or life, and then all the
rest of the property to be divided equally
among all my Children at the death of my
beloved wife, and I leave my eldest sons
James and Andrew, and Lemuel Wilson as
my Executors of this my last will and Testament, this 25
day of May 1863.
