

Georgia, } In the name of God Amen I Moses
 Sanders M. of the State of Georgia & County
 of Franklin being of sound & disposing
 mind & memory & calling to mind that it
 once appointed for all men to die I constitute
 & make this my last will & Testament hereby revoking
 all other former wills & Testaments made or intended
 to be made First I will that all my just
 Debts as shall be by me owing at my death
 together with all charges touching the paying of or
 otherwise concerning this my will shall in the first
 place be Paid out of my personal Estate & Effects
 & from & after payment thereof & subject thereto
 this my will is that all the residue of my Estate of
 every description shall be appraised & except the
 part I hereafter find my wife & after such
 Appraise made that the said shall be divided as
 follows I will that my Land shall be divided
 into four Equal Parts except what I am now
 about to give & has decided away with a small
 bit of Land to my son John Sanders adjoining the
 place whereon I now live Beginning at Buck
 Corner at the mouth of the Branch on the River
 running thence to the Branch where my river line
 joined the branch. Thence up the branch to the
 old line thence along the old line to the other
 Branch, above, and one hundred acres I give
 unto Jones & Joel Sanders across the upper
 End of the Four hundred acres tract of Land
 Granted to my self joining Melreds old cabin
 and the residue of my property of all description
 what ever I wish divided into five Equal parts
 (To wit) First I give unto my son Moses Sanders
 In one Fourth part of my Land & one Fifth part
 of the residue of my Estate. Then I give unto
 my son John Sanders Forty Dollars and fourth
 part of my Land & one fifth part of the residue
 of my Estate. Then I give to my son Aaron
 Sanders Two Dollars for his portion of my Estate
 Then I give to Aaron Sanders Children Nancy
 James Joel, Moses, Nathaniel, Daniel, Polly
 & Sally Sanders one fourth part of my Land
 and fifth part of the residue of my Estate & also
 give unto them one Negro Girl & the increase if any
 what I sent to my son Aaron Sanders during his
 Life By the name of Barseba

I Give unto my grand children of David Sanders
Deceased namely (To wit) Harter Washinton Sally
Nancy & David Sanders one negro boy named Buck
which I before sent my son David Sanders Deceased
one fourth part of my Land & one fifth part of
the residue of my Estate to be Equally divided between
them I Give I Give unto my Daughter Sally
Hooper Two Dollars I Give unto my grand
children of Sally Hooper namely (To wit)
William Sanders obadiah Betsey Carter & James
Hoopers Two negroes Lewis & Hannah which negroes
I before sent to my Daughter Sally Hooper
& one fifth part of the residue of my Estate except the
Land to be Equally divided between them also Twenty
Dollars in Cash I Give unto Richard
Maulden Two Dollars

I Give I Give unto my wife
Mary Sanders during her life the Land whereon
I now live & three negroes Dinah, Rachael &
Fann & four Cows & Calves Two Horses Two
Sows & pigs Two Feather Beds & furniture all my
Household & kitchen furniture my plantation
& working Tools & sufficient support for her
one year after my Death to be Levied out of
my Estate & after my Wifes Death my will
is for all the property I have sent her to be
Equally divided into five parts except the Land
my son John Sanders is to have & my sons Moses
Sanders & John Sanders is to have each one fifth
part & my grand children herebefore named of Aaron
Sanders to have one fifth part & to be Equally divided
between them

I Give unto my grand children of David Sanders
Deceased before mentioned & one fifth part I give unto
my grand children of Sally Hooper before
mentioned to be Equally divided between them
I Give And my Express will is that I ordain and
appoint my sons Moses Sanders & John
Sanders My sole Executors & this my last will &
Testament given under my hand & seal this the
Twenty eighth day of February in the year of our
Lord one thousand eight hundred & seventeen
intestined before ofenceal Signed, sealed & delivred in
