 last will and Testament, principally of all I recommend

 (Viz) 1st I give and bequeath unto my beloved wife Susan Williams all my estate both real and personal during her natural life, or until the expiration of her widowhood. 2nd That at the expiration of her widowhood, or at her death, I hereby authorize my executors to pay, my daughter Sally Hendrick the sum of thirty dollars and twenty five cents, and Polly Hendrick thirty dollars and twenty five cents, and to my Grand Children (Viz) Susannah Brown, Polly Brown, Meddellow Brown, and Sally Brown the sum of thirty dollars and twenty five cents equally amongst them four, and to William Williams the sum of fourteen dollars twenty five cents, and to Susannah Chubb Eighty dollars and fifty cents, and to Rachel Sartain one hundred and thirty dollars and twenty five cents, and to Nathan Williams, Jr. thirty dollars and twenty five cents, and to Annina Williams one hundred and thirty four dollars, and to Lincy Ballenger thirty dollars and twenty five cents, and to John E. Williams one hundred and thirty five dollars and twenty five cents, also at the above stated times, I give and bequeath unto my two youngest sons, Nathan and John E. Williams, all that tract or parcel of land wherein I now live, containing three hundred and twenty three and a half acres to be equally divided between them, 3rd That after all the above is completed with, that all the balance of my estate both real and personal shall be sold and equally divided between my Children (Viz) Robert Williams, Sally Hendrick, Polly Hendrick, William Williams,
