I Rachel Ramsey of the County and
State of Georgia do make and
ordain this my last will and Testament - I
commend my soul to God who gave it, and my
body to the earth, where it is as taken, to be
buried in a decent manner by my son
James Ramsey.

As touching my worldly estate
I give and dispose of the same in the
following manner

- Item 1st. I give and bequeath unto my son James
Ramsey, Susannah and her children &
her future increase, the power of disposing
of her being completely submitted to my discretion
under the last will and Testament of my husband.
- Item 2nd. The whole of the rest of the personal property
left me, and which still exists at my death
I will and bequeath to my children to be
equally divided between the whole of them;
Share and share alike
- Item 3rd. I will and bequeath unto my son James
Ramsey all the rents, issues and profits
of the life estate left by my said husband,
and which shall remain if any thing there
be unappropriated at my death -

Item 4th I do hereby nominate and appoint my
said son James Ramsey Executor of this
my last will and Testament, annulling
all others and allowing and ratifying this
and no others
