43 (Matters to be read for the same) do make this my last will and Testament, in manner and form following, that is to say, I order my executors herein after named to pay all my Just debts - First I will and give and bequeath unto my beloved wife Elizabeth Malden all my Estate both real and personal consisting of the tract of land whereon I now live, and the tract or parcel of land whereon my son Es Malden now lives, also the following personal property that is to say, two negroes named Pat and John, and also all my personal property consisting of, Goods, and Chattels, household & kitchen furniture, stock and implements of husbandry, to be at the disposal of my beloved wife aforesaid during her natural life, or widowhood, and after her decease, I will and desire that all the estate both real and personal be equally divided amongst all my Children, after the younger Children are made equal with the Elder, then for the remainder whatever it may be, to be equally divided among them all. Lastly I do hereby nominate, constitute & appoint Es Malden & John Henderson Executors of this my last will and Testament, and I do hereby make void all other wills by me heretofore made, and do declare this to be my last will & Testament.
