I Richard Woods of Franklin County & State of Georgia being of Sound Mind & Memory & calling unto mind the Mortality of my Body & knowing that it is appointed unto all men once to die and as touching such worldly Estate wherewith it has pleased God to bless me with in this life I give & dispose of the same in the following manner & form. (Writ) First I Will & recommend the Payments of all my just Debts Second I give & bequeath unto my beloved Wife Nancy Woods all my property both real & personal Consisting of & including my Land & Plantation whereon I now live Containing Three hundred acres more or less bounded by James Hamley John Jewell Thomas Newton & Nathaniel Hicks with all the appurtenances thereunto belonging Also Five negroes (Women to wit) Faithy Sophia Cynthia Charity & Jada Also Twelve Negro Men & Boys (to wit) Joe, Joshua, Lewis, Joel, Reuben,

 should & Kitchen furniture Also All my money
 Bonds notes, debts & claims & demands of every
 description All the above named property I give
 to my beloved wife Nancy Woods during her
 nat. life & at her death it is my & desire that
 Executors divide all my property of every kind
 the one half shall go to each of my sons or persons
 my wife Nancy direct at & before her death
 to them & their heirs forever, ~~and the other~~
 half to be given to my brother William Woods
 theirs forever It is nevertheless my will &
 desire (if the Laws of the State will permit it)
 at the decease of my wife the whole of the
 named negroes shall be completely free as if
 they had never been in slavery It is also my
 will & desire that my two negro women Flora
 & Sylvia & my negro man Billy shall have
 Liberty & live in the Plantation whereon I now
 live & be under the control & direction of my
 beloved wife Nancy Woods during her life
 & at her death the said negroes shall be com-
 pletely free & subject to no person whatever & I
 hereby explain, constitute & appoint my
 wife Nancy Woods, Executrix & Samuel
 Whannon & James M. Little of Franklin
 County, & Samuel Strong of Raleigh
 County, Executors of this my last will & Testa-
 ment Revoking all other wills heretofore made
 by me I do declare, ratify, & confirm in
 no other as my last will & Testament. In
 witness whereof I have here set my hand & seal
 this first day of May A.D. 1816.
