Franklin do make & ordain this my last
Will & Testament viz. after all are paid I
do will unto my wife Sabitha Neal four
Negroes namely Andrew, Chain, Sarah & age
together with all the Land I live upon or possess
in Franklin County together with all my
Stock of Cattle, Hogs & Sheep together with my
household & kitchen furniture & Waggons &
Team for her to have & hold during her life time
or widowhood & at her Death or Marriage for the
above property to be divided among my Chil-
dren so as to make them Equal.

I give unto my Son William a Negro Boy
named Reuben, To my Daughter Elizabeth
a Negro Boy named Jim, To my son Joel
a Negro named Edmund To my Son
Stephen a negro Boy Mr. Cash To my
Daughter Mary a Negro Boy Mr. Hensley
To my son Robert a negro Boy Mr. Stobert
To my Daughter Elizabeth Caroline a negro
Girl N. Mildy. & To my Daughter Virginia
a Negro Boy Mr. Franklin. & my Daughter
Susan be made Equal with the rest out of
the property left with my wife as there is not a
Negro to give her at present & if my wife bring
forth another Child for that to be made Equal
also out of the property left with my wife
and I also will that one hundred & fifty
acres of Land where Patrick Malloy now
lives be given to my Son William & for him to
have no more share of my Land or property
And the Executors give off such Cattle, sheep
& household furniture as can be conveniently
spared as my Children become of age or marry
& that a Distribution be kept so as to make all
Equal & if any of those Negroes given to my
Children should die before they are give off
my will is for them to be made Equal out of the
property left with my wife.

I do hereby appoint Patrick Malloy, James Allen
& my son William Neal my Executors In
witness whereof I have unto set my hand & seal this the 9 Day of

March 1818
