Item 1st It is my will that my body be
buried in Christian like order
Item 2nd It is my will that my beloved
wife Kizia have five negroes (viz)
Luvie ~~woman~~ and a Luke ~~woman~~ and
Sarah a woman and Lucy a woman
and a mare ^{during her life at her death to be} a gelding
and a mare ^{John Brewster} and my wife
mare and white horse and three
feather beds and furniture and
the lower part of my tract of land
lying on Hudson river beginning
at Daniel Bishes line thence along
a new fence made in the year
Eighteen hundred and thirty nine
leaving a narrow lane between
that fence and Hobley Chandlers
field untill it makes a corner
along an other line of fence next
a south west course untill it comes
to a swamp thence keeping the corner
of the last mentioned fence untill it
strikes Hudson river thence down said
river to Bishes line thence along
said line to the beginning by her
freely ~~held~~ to be possessed during her natural
life or widowhood also one yoke of
oxen and my cart house hold and all
furniture and plantation tools and
my stock of cattle ^{and} hogs & cart to
make use of in any way she sees cause
if she has need to sell any of the above
property she is at the liberty to do
so except the land she is not at the
liberty to sell or rent as I shall

Item 3 It is my will that Polly Chandler have the balance of my land lying on Hudson river dividing by the above named and course to Hudson river thene up the river to Flemings line and at the death of my wife ^{if} she the said Polly Chandler shall ^{have} the whole tract of land I hold on Hudson river during her life and at her death it to belong to her three sons viz Wilkins, Daniel and Johnson Prewett Bounded by Flemings land and Bushes land

Item 4th It is my will to give my grandson Samuel Prewett my tract of land lying in the fork of flat creek joining Sanders Newman and young containing 170 acres be the same moor or less also my negro man Henry and my white mare colt and one feather bed and furniture and one cow & calf when he the said Samuel arrives at the age at one and twenty years of age.

Item 5 It is my will to give my grandson Samuel Riley all that tract of land lying on the north side of Daniller Road containing 187 acres be the same moor or less joining lands of Young and Hezekiah Prewett

Item 6 It is my will to give my daughter Lucy Riley two hundred dollars extra

Item 7 It is my will to give Big a break Prewett my son two dollars

my will to give my son John W. Prevert this tract of land whereon I now live containing 50 to be the same more or less bounded by lands of nicholas Porter Hudson Mize and Elizabeth Prevert also sixteen negroes ~~now~~ in the possession I have delivered them unto him with the stock of hogs good and chattels that is now in his ^{hands} with the plantation tools and black smith tools

Item 9 It is my will that at my death my negro man solomon and my negro boy Ben be sold and my wagon and both my pleasure carriages and 3 head of horses they remain alive untill then to Buck Doch & I in all the above named property to be sold on my present premises from the 9 Item giving 12 months credit after giving public notice at all public places for ten miles round take notice you are not at ~~the~~ liberty to sell solomon at the furthiis moor than ten miles from his wife and children all the above named property from the 9 Item down or the proceeds to be Equally divided between my daughter Lucy Hily the orphans of Samuel Prevert Deceased and Robert W. Prevert and Joseph Prevert and Polly Chander

Item 10th If I should have any money or other standing debts at my decease it shall be Equally divided b/w the four named legatees
