 mare and ^{John of Prewitts} white horse and three
 feather beds and furniture and
 the lower part of my tract of land
 lying on Hudson river beginning
 at Daniel Bashes line thence along
 an old fence made in the year
 Eighteen hundred and thirty nine
 leaving a narrow lane between
 that fence and Polly Chandlers
 field untill it makes a corner to
 along an other line of fence near
 a south west course untill it comes
 to a swamp thence keeping the corner
 of the last mentioned fence untill it
 strikes Hudson river thence down
 river to Bashes line thence along
 said line to the beginning by her
 freely ~~Polly~~ to be possid during her natural
 life or widowhood also one yoke of
 oxen and my cart house hold and other
 furniture and plantation tools and
 my stock of cattle ^{and} hogs & cart to
 make use of in any way she sees cause
 if she has need to sell any of the aforesaid
 property she is at her liberty to do
 so, except the land she is not at
 liberty to sell or rent as I shall

deceased of hereafter

Item 5 It is my will that Polly Chandler have the balance of my land lying on hudson river dividing by the above named and course to Hudson river thence up the river to Flemmings line and at the death of my wife ^{Priscilla} she the said Polly Chandler shall ^{possess} the whole tract of land I hold on hudson river during her life and at her death it to belong to her three sons (viz) Wilkins~~x~~ Daniel and Johnson Prewett Bounded by Flemmings land and Bushes land

Item 4th It is my will to give my grandson Samuel W Prewett my tract of land lying in the fork of flat creek joining Sanders new man and young containing 170 Acres be the same moor or less also my negro man Henry and my white mare colt and one feather bed and furniture and one cow & calf when he the said Samuel arrives at the age at one and twenty years of age.

Item 3 It is my will to give my grandson Samuel Poley all that tract of land lying on the north side of Daniel's Road containing 187 Acres be the same moor or less joining lands of Young and Hezekiah Prewett

Item 6 It is my will to give my daughter Lucy Poley two hundred dollars extra

Item 7 It is my will to give Hezekiah Prewett my son two dollars

It is my will to give my son
John W. Brewette this tract of land
whereon I now live containing 50
be the same more or less bounded
by lands of Nicholas Porter
Hudson Mize and Elizabeth Pre
also sixteen negroes ^{that is now} ~~which~~ in the
possession I have delivered them
unto him with the stock of
hogs good and chattels that is now
in his ^{possession} ~~possession~~ with the planting
tools and black smith tools

Item 9 It is my will that at my death
my negro man Solomon and
my negro Boy Ben be sold and
my wagon and both my plea
carriages and 3 head of horses
they remain alive untill then
Buch Dock & I in all the above
named property to be sold on
my present premises from the 9th of
giving 12 months credit after giving
public notice at all public places for
ten miles Round take notice you are
not at ~~the~~ liberty to sell Solomon
at the ~~particular~~ more than ten miles from
his wife and children all the above
named property from the 9th of
or the proceeds to be Equally divided
between my daughter Lucy Fily the
orphan of Samuel Brewette Deceased
and Robert W. Brewette and Joseph Pre
and Polly Chandler

Item 10th If I should have any money or
standing debts at my Decease
it shall be Equally divided betw
the five last named legates

Item 11th I appoint my son John W Prewett
and George E Bonds to Execute
this my last will and testament
