Georgia } I Stephen Philips of said State
Franklin County } and County being low in health
but of sound mind and disposing memory, and
calling to mind that it is once appointed for man
to die and after that the Judgment, as made
and Ordain and constitute this as my last
will and Testament - as regards my soul
I resign it to God my Creator, and my
Body I resign it to its mother dust. And
as for the little property it has pleased
God to bless me with, I give and bequeath
it as follows - My land whereon I now
live consisting of two hundred acres, and
also my forty acre lot by me drawn in
the County of Cobb, One barrel Horses
and all my stock of cattle, sheep & hogs,
also the household and kitchen furniture,
all of which after paying all my Just debts

I give and bequeath to my dear wife during her natural life or widowhood; and at her death or marriage to be equally divided among my Children - I also appoint my wife Mary Ann my executor - In witness whereof I hereunto set my hand and seal this December 28th Day 1840

State of Georgia In the name of God Amen
Franklin County I William Forns of the State and
County aforesaid being old and
on the decline of life but being of sound mind
and good memory and calling to mind the
mortality of the body and that it is appointed that
man shall die.

I do make and ordain this my last will and Testa-
ment hereby revoking all former will by me made,
First I resign my Soul to God who gave it me and
my body to a decent Christian burial - Nothing doubting
that they will be reunited at the general resurrection
and as to what worldly goods He has pleased God to
bless me with in this life I dispose of the following
manner

Items, &c I wish all my just debts to be paid.
