weak in body, but of sound & perfect mind &
memory, Thanks be to God for the same, & calling
to mind the mortality of our nature do make
& ordain this my last will & Testament, & first I
give & bequeath my soul into the hands of Almighty
God who gave it, & body I resign to the grave,
to decently buried at the discretion of my Executors,
& as touching my worldly Estate where with it hath
been pleased God to bless with, I give & dispose
of them in the following manner & form (Viz)
Item, I give & bequeath unto my beloved wife
Martha Thompson one negro named Hardy,
having her winder hood, one dark bay mare named
Bonny, four cows and calves, to her and her heirs
forever - Item I give and bequeath unto Mary
Thompson, one negro named Abby, four cows
and calves, one dark bay mare named Fannie,
to her and her heirs forever. Item, I give and
bequeath unto my daughter Elizabeth Thompson
one negro named Sarah, one sorrel mare
four head of cattle, to her and her heirs forever
Item, I give & bequeath unto my Daughter
Rebecca Thompson one negro named Davey
four head of cattle, to her and her heirs fore-
ever. Item I give and bequeath unto my son
Moore Thompson one negro named Jack
one sorrel colt, my lands and all the remain-
der of my estate, both real and personal, to
him & his heirs forever - except one bed and
furniture, & the kitchen furniture, which
I give & bequeath unto my beloved wife Martha
Thompson. I do hereby the 2nd day 1801. I nominate
& appoint John Sandridge & John Gatewood to
Execute this my last will & Testament
