 me in any wise before made and bequeathed,
 ratifying & confirming this & no other to be
 my last will & Testament, in witness whereof
 I have hereunto set my hand & seal this fourth
 day of April 1804

 grand son, I hereby bequeath unto him the sum
 of three hundred dollars to be laid out in the
 purchase of a negro -
