made his certain Bond in writing in the form
following, I know all men by these presents that
Peter Thomas of the County of Wilkes and State
of Georgia am held & firmly bound unto James
Lockheart of the said County & State in the just
& full sum of five hundred Pounds, good
and lawful money of the State of Georgia
to be paid to the said James Lockheart, his
certain attorney, his Executors, Administrators
or assigns whatever, to which payment well
& truly to be made, I do hereby bind myself
my heirs Executors &c firmly by these presents
sealed with my seal & dated this 1st day of July 1788
The Condition of the above obligation is
such that if the said Peter Thomas

"Thomson His Executors He shall well & truly make
a right & title to a tract of Land in Franklin County,
On a bounty warrant containing two Hundred eight
seven and a half acres, after the fee of the said Land
are paid, then the above obligation to be void or
else to remain in full force, & virtue, signed
sealed & delivered in presence of
Walter Richardson Peter Thomson *Seal*

On motion of Mr Cook Attorney for
Jas. Cookhart, it is Ordered that the administrators
of the intestate estate of said Peter Thomson be-
~~be~~ directed to make titles to the said tract
of land agreeable to said bond, if no objections
shall be made thereto during the next term, and
it is further Ordered that a notice be published
in one of the public Gazettes of this state, and in
the public places of the county, for the space of three
months agreeable to the statute in such case made
& provided -
