I Thomas Heaney of the State of South Carolina & District of Pendleton Considering the uncertainty of this mortal life & being of sound & perfect mind & Memory Blessed Be the Almighty God for the same I do make & Publish this my last will & Testament in manner & form following (viz) in the first I allow my Body to be buried in a decent manner & form & all my funeral expenses & just debts to be paid by my Executors & next to my beloved wife Elizabeth Heaney her next woman ^{I give} ~~to be~~ ^{to be} used & disposed of by her with my think proper at her Decease Also I do bequeath & give in Franklin County Georgia Containing Two hundred Eighty Seven acres together with the household & Kitchen furniture & stock of every kind not hereafter excepted

And Thirdly I do authorize my Executors if I should not make Sale of my Land in Carolina to Sell the same & appropriate the proceeds as aforesaid directed & if I should sell the said Land & allow my wife Elizabeth to deliver unto my Executors the proceeds thereof & if it does not contain Eight hundred Dollars to make out the sum of Eight hundred Dollars to my Executors out of any property which she may think fit that I have left to her own disposal at her decease & if the said produces 800 Dollars then the property before mentioned to be entirely at her disposal

In the next place my will is that the before mentioned Eight hundred Dollars be Equally divided Namely Four hundred payable by my Executors to my brother Hugh Heaney or his heirs or Attorney & the other Four hundred to be paid in the same way to Elizabeth Blair her heirs or their attorney Both of which now since (if alive) in the Kingdom of Ireland County of Down near Clough Mills & my will is that my after named Executor as soon as practicable after my Decease do the Eight hundred Dollars & use the same to the best advantage for the Legatees until required of them in a Legal way & if the aforesaid Legatees be not ^{apptd} ~~apptd~~ ^{by the State} ~~by the State~~ ^{within the term of Seven} years after my Decease then my will is that my Executors pay over said money for the use of the Poor of the District unto hands of the Commissioners appointed for that purpose

And lastly my will is that James McDill Hugh Wilson
William Turner or any two of them do execute this
Last Will & Testament and I do hereby revoke all
wills by me made & do declare this to be my Last
will & Testament & I do also appoint & ordain
persons before named to duly execute the same
In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand
this Thirty first day of January one thousand eight
hundred & Twenty one in the 44th year of Ashures
