County and lying the south fork of Broad River  
being my first tract I hold on said south fork of  
Nathaniel Payne own survey, containing two  
hundred acres - Thirdly I give and bequeath  
to my beloved brothers Champer, Shewsbury  
Gekadiah, Payne deator and Cleveland Payne, and  
my sister Ruth Payne one tract of land a part  
of some of my land, to be as near the value of  
the other tracts, I have given to my aforesaid brother  
Nathaniel & Moses Payne, and neither of my aforesaid  
brothers nor sister to be visited with authority  
of making sale or conveying the aforesaid land  
without the approbation of a majority of my executors  
hereafter mentioned, and the rest of my estate, both  
real and personal, after my lawful debts and  
to be disposed as follows, that is to say the negro  
that Colo Benjamin Cleveland is owing me in  
case my beloved father should die before the death  
of my beloved mother Yannah Payne, said negro  
during her life, and after her death, to be equal  
divided together with the rest of my estate, be it  
all my blood brothers step brothers and sisters, and  
in case of my brothers or sisters or either of their  
death without having any heir of his her or their  
body, that their part of my said estate shall be equal  
divided between the rest of my brothers and sisters  
and I do also hereby constitute and ordain  
my beloved father and my friend John Cochran

William Lawton and Richard White my sole Executors  
of this my last will and testament, in witness whereof  
I have hereunto set my hand and seal this fifteenth day  
of May in the year of our Lord one thousand seven
