Son of the State of Georgia Young Man
Caught, being in perfect health sound mind
& memory thanks be to almighty God
Calling unto mind the mortality of my Body
& knowing that it is appointed for Man to Die
I do make & ordain this my last Will & Testament
that is to say principally & first of all I give &
recommend my soul unto the hands of Almighty
God that goes it & my Body I recommend to the earth
to be buried in decent Christian Burial at the
discretion of my Executors without any doubting
but at the general resurrection I shall receive the
same again by the mighty power of Almighty
God & as touching such worldly Estate wherewith
it has pleased God to bless me with in this life
I give, demise & dispose of the same in the
following manner to wit, Item First I give
& bequeath to my beloved wife Mary White
during her natural life for her support the
whole of my Estate both Real & personal after
paying my just Debts & one negro Girl named
Daisy to dispose of as she pleases after the Decease
of my wife I give & bequeath unto my Daughter
Phoebe Carter Smithson, one Negro Girl named
Sarah & her increase to her & the heirs of her Body
for ever. I give unto my Son Zachariah
White one Negro Boy named Lewis to him &
his heirs for ever after the Decease of my
wife

after the decease of my. I give unto my son
Thomas white one Negro Lad named Bob to him
his heirs for ever after my wifes Deathe
I give unto my Daughter Nancy Dickson
one Negro woman named Rachel & her increas
to her & the heirs of her Body for ever after my
decease I give unto my son William White
one Negro Boy named Joe to him & his heirs
for ever after my wifes Decease I give unto my
son Richard White one Negro Boy named Geo
to him & his heirs for ever after my wifes Decease
I give unto my Daughter Polly Williams one
Girl named Molly & her increas to her & the heirs of
Body for ever after my wifes Decease I give unto my
Daughter Betsy G. Hunt one Negro Girl named
Molly & her increas to her & the heirs of her Body
for ever. Lastly I make & ordain & appoint my son
Thomas White & my son Wm White Executors
of this my Last Will & Testament Disannulling
revoking all other former Wills & Testaments
by me made I've witness whereof I have hereunto
set my hand & affixed my seal in the year of our
Lord one thousand eight hundred & seventeen.
