First I give and bequeath
to my Beloved wife Sarah Ford after
payment of my just debts all of my
Plantations tools and all of my stock
of every description and also all
my household and kitchen furniture
to have and to use or give or divide
amongst my Children as she may
think proper at her own discretion
for and during her natural life
widowhood

Secondly I do appoint my two sons that
is to say Joel and William I do
my Executors with my wife Sarah
Ford to transact all the Business
above named in testimony whereof
I have hereunto set my hand and
affixed my Seal this 29th day
of October 1839
in presence of
