

Georgia In the name of God Amen -
Franklin County I Jackson Herring of the County of
DeKalb and State aforesaid being weak of
body but of sound mind and understanding,
and knowing that it is appointed to all men to
die, do make and Ordain this my last will
and Testament, in manner and form following

- 1st My will is that so much of my personal property
be sold as will be sufficient to pay all my
just debts and that the forth will be paid
- 2 My will is that the balance of my personal pro-
perty be equally divided into three shares, one
of which I give and bequeath to my beloved wife
Polly Herring, the two other shares I will and bequeath
to my beloved brother Isaac Herring, and the
Orphan of my brother Albert Herring I decree
that is one share to the Orphan aforesaid, equally
to be divided amongst them, and the other to
my Brother Isaac Herring as aforesaid, as to
my Land I will that my wife and the Orphan
aforesaid together with their mother, and my
Brother Isaac live on and Cultivate & share
the profits jointly as above, untill the youngest
of the three Orphan aforesaid arrives at the
age of twenty one year, then said land to be
sold, and the proceeds of the sale to be distri-
buted as above, and the part falling to the
Orphan aforesaid, to be subdivided amongst
them equally - I also will to Jackson
Herring when he arrives at the age of twenty one
fourteen a spotted horse called Harry Colt
Lastly I appoint my brother Isaac Herring and
my wife Polly my Executors, signed sealed &
acknowledged in presence of us this 15th Novr. 1879

erty where with it has pleased God to bless me with
in this life, I give and bequeath and dispose of in the

I give and bequeath to my beloved wife Fanny
two negroes named York, and Nancy, and
for said negroes to remain in the possession of
my beloved wife Fanny during her lifetime -
Also I give and bequeath unto my aforesaid beloved
wife one brown cow & calf, and one spunk like
