I Elizabeth Hain of the State of Georgia & County of Fulton
being of sound and disposing mind and memory and
being desirous of settling my worldly will & testament hereby
do to do this day make this my last will & testament hereby
revoking all wills by me at any time made (if any prior
to this date

I Command my soul to God who quick and my body
I desire should be buried in a Christian like manner and
my worldly estate I dispose of as follows

That after my death it is my will that my estate
both real and personal be divided amongst my heirs
Equally (viz John J Hain William P Hain Joel B Hain Robert
G B Hain and Mary Amanda Worby and Eric P Sewell
Son & heir of my daughter Anna E Sewell and if the said Eric P Sewell
die without having any natural heir then and in that case his portion of my
estate (which is one eighth) is to come back to the surviving heirs of my
estate and to my daughter Nancy E Redwine and the heirs of
her body I give and bequeath one eighth part of my estate which
will be an equal share with the balance of my estate in and in the
Control of her husband John M Redwine and to E. Anna Maria

Peacock daughter & heir of the body of my deceased daughter
Sarah Ann J Peacock I bequeath one eighth part of my estate
and if the said E. Anna Maria should die without leaving any
heir of her body then and in that case her part of my estate
is to come back to the surviving heirs of my estate

And it is my will and desire that after my death that
the Executors of my will shall have power and authority
the grave of my said husband a well and substantial
Tomb to be for ever also over the grave of my body in
the same form and manner as said my deceased husband
to be paid for out of my estate

That the same said tomb with a well and substantial be
placed over the grave of my deceased daughter Anna
E Sewell's Sarah Ann J Peacock to be paid for out of
them estates respectively (viz the estate of Eric P Sewell
& E. Anna Maria Peacock

And it is my will and desire that Joel R. Hain be my
Executor to see that my Last will and Testament be faithfully
Carried out & executed

5th And I further affirm and it is my wish that that Joel R. Hain
be & act as trustee for my daughter Nancy & I Redman & her
Children and Lovie Russell And that Mary A. Parby act
as trustee for David Green Peacock
