Item fourth I desire to my son Allen P. Poole for his own use for
one hundred and Number One & Two in the fourteenth district of originally
being in DeKalb County, And lot of land Number Sixty three in the
fourteenth district of originally being in DeKalb County.

Item fiftieth I devise to my son Ephraim M. Poole for his own use and
use of land Number thirty one, thirty three and thirty four in the four
towns district of originally Henry now Fulton County.

Item Sixty, I bequeath to my daughter Margaret Rebecca Taliaferro
my Negro Woman Jim about thirty three years old of dark complexion
and all her Children, and Stephen a boy about thirteen years old of
dark complexion, to her and to her heirs forever.

Item Seventh, I bequeath to my Grand daughter Margaret McHarg
thrasher. My Negro Woman Rachel about twenty five years old of dark
complexion to her. To her heirs forever.

Item Eighth, I bequeath to my daughter Sarah Hutchinson children
my Negro woman Riley and all of the said Negros children and all
the increase she may have from this time.

Item Ninth, I devise to my son in law Samuel G. Johnson one hundred
and fifty acres more or less bordering the East Side of River and Number
Sixty six in the fourteenth lot of originally Henry the fourteenth.

Item tenth, I devise and bequeath to my son in law Matt Marshall
Poole all the rest and residue of my property other real or personal
every description not herinbefore ^{hereby} excepted it for and during his
natural life to be controlled by his and my direction and at his death
my will and desire is that the same be equally divided amongst
all my children (except my daughter Margaret Taliaferro) who have less
than hundred dollars less than the other children having given her
that amount before their and the day they come to account her
daughter Sarah Hutchinson, they will be subject to distribute
and the sum that goes to my daughter Margaret to be her her
life time, and at her death to be divided among her children
except Stephen without distinction there to her and to her
children in equal parts to the rest.

Item Eleventh, I constitute and appoint my Slave Tom Thomas M.
Poole, of Unionville to execute, sign, seal, & administer to this my last
will and testament this 11th day of March 1858.
