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Hutton County do make this my last will and testament the following
as my last will and testament

- 1st Intending now to make a final disposition of my property & effects - I hereby revoke any and every prior testamentary paper made by me.
- 2^d Now it shall please God to end my life here I desire to be buried in a decent manner suitable to my condition in life.
- 3^d As soon there after as shall be practicable I will and direct that my executor hereinafter named shall pay off and discharge all debts which I may justly owe.
- 4th I give and bequeath to my wife Mary a Abbath one half of all my Estate Real and personal which may remain after paying my debts as aforesaid.
- 5th Of the other remaining half (after the debts are paid as aforesaid) I give and bequeath to Lewis S. Abbath as Trustee for my Mother Nancy Abbath the sum of Fourteen hundred & Eighty Dollars \$1480.00 to be by said Lewis S. Abbath invested for the benefit of my said Mother and in Mortgage to be subject to the debts or liabilities of my said Mother present or any future husband and I hereby will and direct that my said Mother shall receive from her said Trustee only the proceeds or interest of & on said sum which said Trustee is hereby directed to pay to her in person annually for and during the term of her natural life.
- 6th At the death of my Mother I will and bequeath that said Fourteen hundred and Eighty dollars or the property in which it may at that time be invested shall be divided equally between my Sisters Emily H. and George C. Abbath.
- 7th I give and bequeath all the residue of my Estate Real and personal after paying my debts and the legacies aforesaid to my Sisters Emily H. and George C. and my brothers William S. and Benjamin H. Abbath to be equally divided between the four.
- 8th I do hereby appoint Lewis S. Abbath of said County of Hutton Executor of this my last will and testament. In Testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand this fifth day of September Eighteen hundred and sixty two.
