with all the rights & members & appurtenances to the same in any
mire belonging to her own proper use benefit & honor forever
with full power to dispose of the same at any time previous or
by will ordered at her death as she may think proper

4th I hereby constitute & appoint, S. W. Thompson, of Milledge-
ville, County Executor of this Will & Testaments!

I Elizabeth Fain of the State of Georgia & County of Fulton
being of sound and disposing mind and memory and
being desirous of settling my worldly while I have thought
so to do this day make this my last Will & Testament hereby
retracting all wills by me at any time made by any prior
to this date

I command my soul to God who quick and my body
I desire should be buried in a Christian like manner and
my worldly estate I dispose of as follows

That after my death it is my will that my estate
both real and personal be divided amongst my heirs
Equally (viz John J. Fain William & Fain Joel S. Fain Robert
A. B. Fain and Mary Amanda Worby and Erie Penwell
Son & heir of my daughter Anna Penwell and if the said Erie Penwell
die without having any natural heir then and in that case in portion of my
estate which is one eighth, also comes back to the surviving heirs of my
estate and to my daughter Nancy Penwell and her heirs if
her body I give and bequeath one eighth part of my estate which
will be an equal share with the balance of my estate from the
Control of her husband John H. Penwell. Next to F. A. also issues
Peacock's daughter & heir of the body of my deceased daughter
Sarah Ann Peacock I bequeath one eighth part of my estate
and if the said Leada Fain should die without heirs my
heir of her body then and in that case in part of my estate
is to revert back to the surviving heirs of my estate

And it is my will and desire that
the residue of my will shall remain and rest over my
The grave of my Beloved Husband a well and substantial
Tomb in box form also over the grave of my body in
the same form and manner as our my deceased Husband
to be paid for out of my estate

That the same Tomb both man & rest substantial be
placed over the grave of our deceased Daughter Anna
Penwell & son, Erie & Peacock to be paid for out of
their estates respectively (viz the estate of Erie Penwell
& Leada Fain Peacock)

4th And it is my will and desire that Joel R. Hain be my Executor to see that my Last will and Testaments be faithfully carried out & executed.

5th And I further affirmt and it is my wish that that Joel R. Hain be & act as trustee for my daughter Nancy & I Bedeau & her Children and Eddie Fawell And that Harry & Party act as trustee for Grand Uncle Peacock
