of this will, And upon the Marriage or death of my wife
It is my will that the entire estate above mentioned with
its increase be divided between my two Sons James Living
and William Lee equally

Item 3rd I hereby Revoke and annul I appoint my wife
to Carry into effect this Will as my Executor
