

The last Will and Testament of Francis Gilloon of Atlanta
Georgia in the Name of God Amens

I Commit my Soul to God who gave it and my body to the
Mother Earth

Item 1st I will that all my just debts be paid, namely, one
of money arising from dividends on my P. P. Stock, or run
or sale of my houses and lots in the City of Atlanta inc-
luding the expense of my demise and burial.

" 2^d I will and bequeath to the President and Directors
for the time being of the American Colonization Society
for the purpose of said Society sending them to Liberia
Africa all my slaves. (to wit) Samuels 55 years of age, Bo-
y 48, and her three Childrens boy Charles 22, Sarah 16
and Lubertha Brown 8 years old, & Leona Seven Children
Sarah 34, Elie 29, Harriet 27, Beulah 24, Nancy 19,
Harriet 14, Clara 10 years old, Andrew Children
(boy) America 15, Leon Brown 14, George in Jun 9, Eliza 8
Thomas Headman 4, Harriets four Childrens (boy) Will-
ard Brown 9, Amanda 7, Caroline 5, William 2 years old.
Sarah James Child named Anna, Anna, Elizabeth, Sister
of Plymouth 60, Brown 42 years old and our Childrens
Little Anna 31, Martha 19, Elizabeth 17, and Beulah 14 years old

" 3rd I will and bequeath to each one I leave to by said
by my Executors when they start to Liberia in the event of its
before they start to Liberia one hundred dollars each

" 4th I will and bequeath me Third Bond Stock, P. P. Stock
and lots in the City of Atlanta, One third undivided interest
equally, One of the Dividends, and two lots in Gordon
County to be divided as follows: One third hereof to my
Daughters Louisiana & Carlotta to receive the interest on her
one third annuities or Dividends paid into her hands
by my Executors until set into the hands of her husband nor
her children during her natural life time, and after her
decease the said third, so derive the interest from dur-
ing her natural life time, I will and bequeath to the Coloni-
zation people of Liberia to be equally divided among them
The Colonization Society to take charge of said third at my
Daughters death, and divide it equally among the Coloni-
zation people and their descendants that I send to Liberia

" 5th One third of said stock, bonds, and lots to be sold

"6th The remaining third of my Stock, City Lots &c I
will and bequeath to the President and Directors of the
the American Colonization Society to distribute equal
among my Colored people and their descendants I send to
Liberia in Africa.

"7th I will that my remains be decently interred with a
decent Tomb Stone with my name inscribed, that my friends
may find where my remains are deposited.

"8th I will that my Executors be amply compensated for
carrying this my Last Will and Testament into execution.

"9th I appoint Mr Nathan Fleetwood and Ebenezer Chase
both of Athens Georgia my Executors to carry this my last
Will and Testament into execution, and in the event of
death or any other contingency failing them so as to
prevent their executing this will, the testator desire is
that the Inferior Court of this County shall set about
and appoint such person or persons as in their wisdom
will execute this will according to the intent and spirit
of this will.

I will and bequeath to my wife my Name 25
day of June Eighteen hundred and fifteen.
