depart this life clean in the light & proper to the objects my
Family & myself that I shalld make a disposition of the safety
with which a kind Providence has equipped me to manage maste this
my last will & Testament hereby recarying all other made by me
Item 1st I desirous and desire that my body be buried in a decent
Christian like manner my soul I trust shall return to you with
God who giveth as I trust receive for Eternall salvation through
the merits & atonement of the Lord Jesus Christ my Saviour
Christ whose religion I have professed as I heartily trust enjoyed for
more than twenty five years

Item 2^d I desire most desirous that all my just debts be paid
without delay by my executors hereinafter named appointed as
as I am unwilling my executors should be delayed in their rights
especially as there is no necessity for delay

Item 3^d I give herewith & desire it may be known to all
knowing with whom I have resided in the greatest quiet for over
Thirty years this house set on Peachtree Street in Decatur
Stand in the City of Atlanta together with all the out houses on
said lot next all the furniture and kitchen furniture in sum

Item 4^d I give and bequeath to my beloved wife wife from
formerly belonging to Benj Wilson about the age of
and his wife about fifty two years old

My Negro man Sam about twenty three years old my Negro boy Billy about twenty four years old
My Negro girl Maria about eighteen years old her two children Dorothy & Agnes about nine months old & Lucy about three months old their increased my Negro man King about twenty four years old My Negro boy Arnold about twenty three years old my Negro girl Mary about twenty two years old her two children Harry about two years old & Adolphus about eight months old her increased my Negro boy George about twenty years old and my Negro man Brown about twenty four years old

Item 5th I give and bequeath to my beloved wife five hundred dollars in Money or good Notes that she may choose out of all the notes belonging to my estate two Cows & Calves such as she may choose from my Stock of Cattle

Item 6th And in consideration of the disobedience of my daughter Sarah Ann in marrying against my will and advice it is best my will that she shall inherit any property of my estate but in as much as I have already given to her Leving Children Charles Howard Harris & Barbara Wilson Harris a Negro Girl apiece worth Six hundred Dollars I do direct that each of my Executors advance from their portion of the estate the sum of two hundred dollars which sum of Money amounting to Six hundred dollars to each child she may then after have which shall be used for the purchase of a Negro Girl to be given by deed of gift signed by all the Executors to each child in my will after Name when it arrives at the age of three years old

Item 7th The residue of my Property both Real & Personal whom ever

Whatever it may be I give & bequeath to my two sons Charles Howard & William Pinney Howard to be equally divided between them & their issue during their natural lives part of the same to their Children and if they do not so divide it among themselves then in that case half of it shall be divided equally between the Children of William P Howard if there be any living and if any Son William P Howard dies & not leave any Children of his own then in that case his property shall be divided equally between the Children of Rufus A Howard that may be living forever

Item 8th I hereby constitute & appoint my beloved wife Temperance Emily Pinney Howard & my son Rufus A Howard and my son William P Howard Executors of this my last will & Testament this the thirty first day of October A.D. 1863 eighteen hundred and sixty three signers whose signatures declared in the presence

I Am a Mason Widower of the City of St. Augustine
 County of St. Johns in the State of Florida being of sound
 mind and disposing in view of the uncertainty of life do
 hereby make publish & declare this my last will & Testament
 revoking and making null and void all former wills made
 by me at any time. The worldly estate with which God in his
 goodness has been pleased to intrust me I give & dispose of as
 follows

Item first. I direct on my decease my body to decently &
 suitably interred in such place & manner as my dear daughter
 may direct & that all my funeral expenses & just debts be
 paid from any part of my estate as soon after my decease as my
 executors can conveniently do it.

Item Second

I give devise & bequeath to my dear daughter
 Maria E Postlethwait & Matilda D. Hines all my property
 and estate real or personal of every nature & kind & whatsoever the
 same may be situated including all my negroes in the state
 of Florida & the sum of which I may be possessed thereof
 or even at the time of my death to be equally divided between
 them share & share alike without after division.
