2<sup>d</sup> I give and bequeath to my wife Mary Ann Franklin one tract of  
land in Chester district to co of two hundred and fifty acres adjoining  
Thomas Sanders on the north & Churchill Carter on the west & the other  
part of land in Chester district to co about 8 miles from the Courthouse  
of said district at the Fish Paw Ferry road bounded south by lands of Cornelius  
Perry East by lands of Eli Cornwall South by lands of Nick Calenord &  
west by lands of Joseph Green lying on the waters of Needy River containing  
four hundred & twenty four acres thereon John Grissell formerly resided  
& All my interest in my lands in the state of Texas in which I have paid only  
part of the purchase money the balance being unpaid.

3<sup>d</sup> I give and bequeath to my said wife a negro woman named Lucy and  
her child John about 15 years old most unwillingly under the will of the said  
Amy now living out in the city of Augusta Georgia I stipulate for three thousand  
Dollars on G Franklin of Mississippi had a legal note for one thousand fifty  
dollars on Mr Mayes Attorney at law and all the rest and remainder  
of my property of every description both real & personal.

4<sup>a</sup> I do hereby free and bequeath all the above and foregoing to my said  
wife and to her heirs forever to do by her friends immediate and offend  
my said wife my executors in this my last will & testament for  
the memory of them hereunto set my hand & seal this 24<sup>th</sup> day  
of February 1863 in purpose

family & myself that I should make a declaration of the safety

my last will & Testament hereby desiring all others made to me  
this 1<sup>st</sup> October and desirous that my family be assured in a moment  
Chattelin like manner my soul & flesh shall return to you with  
God who gave it as I trust, in view of eternal life through  
the merits & atonement of the Saviour. And now, wherein Jesus Christ  
whose religion I unprofessed as I recollect but enjoyed for  
more than twenty five years

Item 1<sup>st</sup> I desire to set down that all my just debts be paid  
without delay by my executors prominently named opposite me  
as I am unwilling they should be delayed in their right  
especially as there is no necessity for delay.

Item 2<sup>nd</sup> I give herewith & desire signing the enclosed will. This paper  
concerning which I have recd in the strictest quiet for over  
Thirty years. This document I am desirous to have sealed with an Execution  
mark in the City of Atlanta together with all the other Houses on  
said lot and all the furniture and its contents in some  
hours.

Item 3<sup>rd</sup> I give and bequeath to my beloved wife as the sum  
formerly belonging to her. I well knew about the age of  
and her self thirty four fifty two years old
