

The Will of James Lyle Deceased

for their children after their deaths during their children's minority  
Item the 5<sup>th</sup> I give and bequeath to the children of my deceased daughter Louisa Jane Poynter five dollars

Item 6<sup>th</sup> I give and bequeath to my daughter Mary Ann Elizabeth Tullian five dollars

Item 7<sup>th</sup> In the event of their being a residue of my estate after paying all just debts and expenses as will be necessary to carry out the provisions of my will and paying the legacies therein named it is my will and desire that said residue be equally divided among all of my children then living and the children of such as may be dead giving to the children of such of my children that may have died the proportion going to their parent.

Item 8<sup>th</sup> It is my will and desire that in the event of the death of either of my four children James H. John H. Sarah Emma or Minerva Ella and without issue that the estate bequeathed to them be equally divided among the survivors of the said four children and that in the event that all four of said children dying without issue it is my will and desire that the property bequeathed to them be equally divided between my daughter Mary Ann Elizabeth Tullian and the children of my deceased daughter Louisa Jane Poynter

Item 9<sup>th</sup> It is my will and desire that all such property that may pass to the children of my deceased daughter Louisa Jane Poynter and to Mary Ann Elizabeth Tullian by virtue of this my last Will and Testament be taken charge of by my executors herein-after-named and be by them controlled and managed as trustees for the use of my said deceased daughter Louisa Jane Poynter children and Mary Ann Elizabeth Tullian and for her children during their minority

Item 10<sup>th</sup> I hereby nominate and appoint Robert Mc Clark and Thomas H. Brubaker executors of this my last will and testament this the 19<sup>th</sup> day of October 1858 Eighteen hundred and fifty eight

I will also desire that Mrs. Holden & sofa & children have  
the interest on income of \$1,500 dollars and dollars during  
her natural life and after her death the sum of ten thousand  
dollars to be equally divided with my children  
except Holden & Haingswe and her late son ~~James~~  
dollars the other children Edwin C. and William, Henry  
H. Haingswe, Nelly, C. Smith, Anna J. Haingswe, Martha H. Haingswe  
Martha Haingswe, Anna H. Haingswe, William Haingswe, Henry P.  
Haingswe. The equal distribution with all the above  
named children except the said H. C. Haingswe as above  
all my estate I desire to be sold by my executors
