

The Will of James Lloyd Deceased

for their children after their deaths during their childrens minority
Item the 5th I give and bequeath to the children of my deceased daughter
Louisa Jane Poyzman five dollars

Item 6th I give and bequeath to my daughter Mary Ann Elizabeth
Tulliam five dollars

Item 7th In the event of their being a residue of my estate after
paying all just debts and expenses as will be necessary to carry out
the provisions of my will and paying the legacies therein named
it is my will and desire that said residue be equally divided among
all of my children then living and the children of such as may
be dead giving to the children of such of my children that may
have died the proportion going to their parent.

Item 8th It is my will and desire that in the event of the
death of either of my four children James W. John H. Sarah
Emma or Minerva Ella and without issue that the estate
bequeathed to them be equally divided among the survivors of
the said four children and that in the event that all four of
said children dying without issue it is my will and desire
that the property bequeathed to them be equally divided between
my daughter Mary Ann Elizabeth Tulliam and the children
of my deceased daughter Louisa Jane Poyzman

Item 9th It is my will and desire that all such property
that may pass to the children of my deceased daughter
Louisa Jane Poyzman and to Mary Ann Elizabeth
Tulliam by virtue of this my last Will and Testament
be taken charge of by my Executors hereinafter named and
be by them controlled and managed as Trustees for the
use of my said deceased daughter Louisa Jane Poyzman
children and Mary Ann Elizabeth Tulliam and for her
children during their minority

Item 10th I hereby nominate and appoint Robert
Mc Clark and Thomas H. Smith Executors of this my last
will and Testament this the 19th day of October
1858 Eighteen hundred and fifty eight

Edm W Holland my executor of my estate
I will and desire that my estate be divided as follows
The interest on income of \$50000 be divided during
her natural life and after my death the said fifteen hundred
dollars to be equally divided with my children
except Fredrick C Mangrum and to him five hundred
dollars the other children to him Edward Williams, Mary
H Mangrum, Kelly C Smith, Susan C Mangrum, Harriet H Mangrum
Charles Mangrum, Sarah H Mangrum, William Mangrum, John P
Mangrum. Be equal distribution with all the above
named children except the said F C Mangrum as above
all my estate I desire to be sold by my executor
