I give and bequeath unto my friend Lewis Lawshe the East half of lot of land No One hundred and Nine in the fourteenth district of Originally Henry Now Fulton County (except that part of said half lot I have already sold off) to be held by in Trust for the use and benefit of my beloved Father and Mother John M. Master Sen. and Elizabeth M. Master and to be managed by said Lewis Lawshe as such Trustee, And the rents issues & profits to be applied to their Maintenance free from their debts or Contracts during their Natural lives, And at their death, or at the death of the Survivor of them, the said parcel of Land to be sold by my Trustee, who is hereto Authorized to sell and convey the same in such Manner as he may deem most for the interest of the parties concerned, and the proceeds to be divided into Six Shares or equal parts, And One Share to be given to each of my Brothers & Sisters (Except my Sister Elizabeth Wife of W. H. Roark) who is to have two Shares thereof, but if any other Brotherly should not be sufficient to pay all my debts then the said Land or portion of said Land being nearest to the City of Atlanta to be sold by my said Executor hereinafter named, and the proceeds to be sufficient for the Burial, And the balance to be paid in full to me or to my heirs & assigns as specified.

provided for me, I have made this my last Will and
Testament hereby revoking and annulling all that heretofore
I have made.

Item first, I desire and direct that my body be buried in decent
and Christianlike manner suitable to my circumstances and condition
my soul I trust shall return to rest with God who I trust as I hope
to eternal salvation through the blood of Jesus Christ.

Item second, I desire and direct that all my just debts be paid
without delay by any person or persons after the manner of law in writing
my creditors should be satisfied of their rights, especially as there is
no necessity for delay.

Item third, I desire to my son Thomas M. Love for his own use
one lot of land Number Sixty, Section nine Township
of the East part of Number Sixteen, and lying and being in the
fourteenth district of originally Henry now Colquhoun County.

Item fourth, I desire to my son Allen J. Love for his own use
one lot of land Number One & Two in the fourteenth district of originally
Henry now Colquhoun County, and lot of land Number Eighteen in the
fourteenth district of originally Henry now Colquhoun County.
